

MANDATORY COURT APPEARANCES OR ARRESTS

Recognizing the concern of the government regarding recidivists and aggravated offenses it is herein provided that if, within the discretion of the law enforcement officer, the offense is of an aggravated nature, the law enforcement officer, notwithstanding the preceding Collateral Forfeiture Schedule, may require the offender to appear before a United States Magistrate Judge, and any punishment established by law, including fine, imprisonment, or probation may be imposed upon conviction. Nothing herein shall prohibit the law enforcement officer from arresting a person for the commission of any offense, including those for which collateral may be posted and forfeited, and taking him/her immediately before a United States Magistrate Judge, or requiring the person charged to appear before a United States Magistrate Judge.

WARRANTS FOR FAILURE TO APPEAR OR FOR FAILURE TO PAY FINE

For those offenses requiring a mandatory appearance, if the offender fails to appear as required, the United States Magistrate Judge shall, upon the request of the government, issue a summons ordering the offender to appear at the next scheduled petty offense date. If the offender again fails to appear, the government may request an arrest warrant based on the charged offense and the offender's failure to appear.

For all other offenses, if the offender fails either to contact the government to dispute the violation notice or to pay the required fine, the government shall send a letter to the offender notifying him/her of the next scheduled petty offense date. The letter also will notify the offender that if he/she fails to pay the fine or to contact the government to dispute the violation notice by that date, then the government will request a summons from the court. If the offender again fails to pay the fine or to contact the government to dispute the violation notice, the United States Magistrate Judge shall, upon the request of the government, issue a summons ordering the offender to appear at the next scheduled petty offense date. Upon issuance of such summons, the government may request that the offense be treated as one requiring a mandatory appearance, and may, in appropriate circumstances, request an arrest warrant for the offender's failure to appear as ordered in the summons.

U.S. ATTORNEY RETAINS CHARGING DISCRETION

Notwithstanding the preceding Collateral Forfeiture Schedule, the United States Attorney's Office, in its discretion, may charge an offender with a different or more serious offense than that identified on the violation notice. Additionally, the United States Attorney's Office, in its discretion, may seek penalties up to and including the maximum penalties established by law, including fine, imprisonment, or probation, regardless of any fine amount entered on the violation notice.

WILDLIFE/PROPERTY FORFEITURE ORDER

Unless otherwise specifically ordered by the Court, any property, wildlife, or wildlife part or product, including but not limited to any hide, skin, flesh, egg, or nest which has been seized within the jurisdiction of the Eastern District of Wisconsin under the authority of the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, 16 U.S.C. 703-711, the National Wildlife Refuge System Improvement Act, 15 U.S.C. §§ 668dd-668ee, the Eagle Protection Act, 16 U.S.C. §§ 668-668e, the Endangered Species Act, 16 U.S.C. §§ 1531-1542, the Migratory Waterfowl Hunting Stamp Act, 16 U.S.C. §§ 718-718i, the Airborne Hunting Act, 15 U.S.C. §§ 742j-742j2, the Marine Mammal Protection Act, 16 U.S.C. §§ 1361-1407, the Lacey Act, 18 U.S.C. § 42, or Lacey Act Amendments, 15 U.S.C. §§ 3371-3378, where final disposition of the case has been made by payment of a forfeiture of collateral or by a judgment by the Court on behalf of the government and where so authorized by statute, the Court herein orders that such wildlife, part, or product shall be forfeited to the government and disposed of by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service in such manner as described by Title 50, Code of Federal regulations, Part 12.

FORFEITURE FOR ORGANIZATION DOUBLE ORDER

Due to the increased liability and potential for environmental degradation posed by commercial and organized activities, the collateral amounts for violations listed herein shall be double. Organization includes a corporation, government or government subdivision or agency, business, trust, estate, club, partnership or association, two or more persons having a joint or common interest, or any other legal entity.

WILDLIFE AND PLANT VALUATION TABLE

The replacement values assigned in this table may be added to the applicable fine amount. A separate replacement value will be added for each fish, wildlife, and plant species possessed, transported, killed, etc., in violation of the law. In cases where the replacement values assigned in this table are lower than the declared value of the item, the higher of the two values will be used.
