PROCEDURAL ORDER

At its September 2007 session, the Judicial Conference approved a new policy to make electronic transcripts of court proceedings available to the public.

Pursuant to the Requirements of the E-Government Act and effective May 1, 2008, transcripts of proceedings held before the U.S. District Judges and Magistrate Judges in the Eastern District of Wisconsin will be filed with the Court in electronic format. The Court will follow the Judicial Conference policy on electronic availability of transcripts before making official transcripts of court proceedings electronically available to the public. This will apply to all transcripts ordered on or after this date, regardless of when the proceeding took place. Voir dire transcripts will not be filed as part of the public record unless otherwise ordered by the Court. The new policy and instructions regarding the electronic availability of transcripts are available on the Court’s website.

It is so ordered.
