AMENDMENT TO CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT PLAN

WHEREAS, the United States District Court for the Western District of Wisconsin has adopted an amendment to its Criminal Justice Act Plan providing for representation by the Community Defender Organization serving this District, to provide representation in that District pursuant to subsection (g)(2)(B) of the Criminal Justice Act (CJA), 18 U.S.C. § 3006A;

WHEREAS, the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Wisconsin wishes to assist the Western District of Wisconsin in implementing its CJA Plan and to allow a Community Defender Organization to serve in that District;

WHEREAS, the geographical proximity of the Eastern District of Wisconsin and the Western District of Wisconsin, and the number and distribution of appointments therein, make it practical and economically feasible for one Community Defender Organization to serve both jurisdictions;

WHEREAS, the Eastern District of Wisconsin and the Western District of Wisconsin are adjacent districts with a sufficient volume of appointments annually to enable the establishment of a Community Defender Organization pursuant to subsection (g)(1) of the CJA;

NOW, IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, subject to the approval of the Judicial Council of the Seventh Circuit, the plan of the Eastern District of Wisconsin for providing representation pursuant to the CJA, is hereby amended to provide that the Community Defender Organization for the Eastern District of Wisconsin shall provide representation in the Western District of Wisconsin pursuant to subsections (g)(1) and (g)(2)(B) of the CJA, and pursuant to the CJA Plan of the Western District of Wisconsin;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the name of the Community Defender Organization in the Eastern District of Wisconsin shall be changed to “Federal Defender Services of Wisconsin, Inc.”;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the corporate bylaws of the Community Defender Organization in the Eastern District of Wisconsin shall be amended to comport with this amendment and with the amended CJA Plan of the Western District of Wisconsin, after which those bylaws shall be annexed to, and incorporated into, this amendment to the CJA Plan of the Eastern District of Wisconsin;


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Community Defender Organization shall continue to operate pursuant to the provisions of subsection (g)(2)(B) of the

CJA, as well as the *Guidelines for the Administration of the Criminal Justice Act and Related Statutes*, Volume VII, *Guide to Judiciary Policies and Procedures*; and


IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that the provisions of the CJA Plan for the Eastern District of Wisconsin, adopted on April 22, 1999, shall remain in effect except to the extent that they are inconsistent with the provisions of this amendment, in which case the provisions of this amendment shall govern.

EFFECTIVE DATE


