ORDER CONCERNING SERVICE OF CRIMINAL
SUMMONSES ON THE MENOMINEE INDIAN RESERVATION

On the motion of William J. Mulligan, United States Attorney for the Eastern District of Wisconsin, and the court being fully advised in the premises,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, pursuant to Rules 4 and 9, Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure and Rule 4(c) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, that all Special Police Officers of the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Department of Interior, are hereby authorized to serve on the Menominee Indian Reservation summonses issued in any criminal action commenced by complaint, indictment or information for the appearance of a defendant before the United States District Court or before any United States Magistrate. This Order shall be effective immediately and shall remain in full force and effect until further order of this court.
