

WHEREAS, Public Law 106-553, § 1(a)(2) [Title III, § 305(a)], Dec. 21, 2000, 114 Stat. 2762, 2762a-84 provides in pertinent part that:

(a) IN GENERAL-The President shall appoint, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate-

(10) 1 additional district judge for the Eastern District of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, Public Law 106-553, § 1(a)(2) [Title III, § 305(c)], Dec. 21, 2000, 114 Stat. 2762, 2762A-85 provides in pertinent part that:

The chief judge of the Eastern District of Wisconsin shall designate 1 judge who shall hold court for such district in Green Bay, Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, President George W. Bush nominated, and with the advice and consent of the Senate, on May 1, 2002, appointed William C. Griesbach of Green Bay, Wisconsin to serve as United States District Judge for the Eastern District of Wisconsin,

NOW THEREFORE, acting by virtue of, and in accordance with, my authority as Chief District Judge, I do herewith designate United States District Judge William C. Griesbach to hold court for the Eastern District of Wisconsin in Green Bay, Wisconsin.
