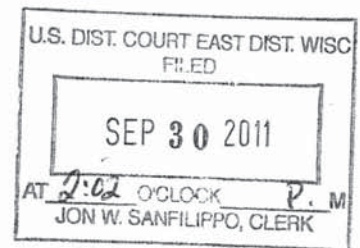

ORDER

After reviewing the requirement that persons must display identification to enter the United States Courthouse in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, and the conditions underlying that requirement, the court concludes that those conditions have abated. Moreover, the 100% identification requirement interferes with legal proceedings and thereby cannot be justified. Hence,

IT IS ORDERED that the 100% identification requirement at the public entrance of the United States Courthouse in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, be terminated immediately.
