In recognition of the changing needs of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Wisconsin for the purpose of Jury Management, the Jury Plan for the United States District Court is amended as follows:

1) Configuration of the Divisions is amended as follows:

a) the Milwaukee Division will consist of the following counties:

Ozaukee, Racine, Walworth, Kenosha,  
Washington, Waukesha, Milwaukee

b) the Green Bay Division will consist of the following counties:

Brown, Calumet, Dodge, Door,  
Florence, Fond du Lac, Forest,  
Green Lake, Kewaunee, Langlade,  
Manitowoc, Marquette, Menominee,  
Marinette, Oconto, Outagamie,  
Shawano, Sheboygan, Waushara, Waupaca,  
Winnebago.

- 2) The minimum number of master jury wheel individuals for the Milwaukee Division is increased to 13,000 voters.
- 3) Local Rule 8.06 - (Communication with Jurors) is incorporated into the Jury Plan.
- 4) In Section 2 - Policy, the sentence, "the Court may on its own motion or motion of the parties select a petit jury venire from any other division of the District Court" is added.
- 5) The phrase "By pardon or amnesty" is stricken from the Qualification Standards for Federal Jurors.


