

In re: Bankruptcy Reform Act of 1994--Jury Trials



The Bankruptcy Reform Act of 1994 amended 28 U.S.C. § 157 to provide that bankruptcy judges may conduct jury trials if authorized to do so by the district court and if the parties to the dispute consent. The United States District Court for the Eastern District of Wisconsin, as evidenced by the signatures of the judges below, expressly authorizes the bankruptcy judges of this district to conduct jury trials pursuant to and consistent with the amendments contained in the Bankruptcy Reform Act of 1994.


