ORDER ESTABLISHING COURT SECURITY COMMITTEE

After consultation with the Judges of this District and pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 566, the Court issues the following order relative to the Court Security Committee for the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Wisconsin. Any prior orders are revoked.

Whereas pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §566(a) the "primary role and mission of the U.S. Marshals' service [is] to provide for the security and obey, execute, and enforce all orders of the United States District Courts." and

Whereas it is the role of the Security Committee to "meet regularly and review the status of existing security in this District, discuss new or changing requirements generated by renovations of new facilities, resolve conflicts or competing requirements for the security resources available to the District and decide which requirements to include in the annual budget call," the following are designated members of said Court Security Committee to carry out this mission.

- (1) The Chief Judge of the District or the Chief Judge's designee.
- (2) The Senior ranking Magistrate Judge of this District.
- (3) The Chief Judge of the Bankruptcy Court.
- (4) The U.S. Marshal.
- (5) The Clerk of Court.
- (6) The United States Attorney.

- (7) The head of Federal Protective Services.
- (8) A representative of the General Services Administration.
- (9) The Chief of Probation.

Said committee shall meet at times designated by the Chief Judge, or the Chief Judge designee, to carry out the aforesaid objectives.
